**Weekly Nugget:** Paul referenced each part of the Hebrew Bible (the Tanakh) in the quotes he used in Romans 12.9-12. The Tanakh (also TNKH) is an acronym of the three parts of the Hebrew Bible. (Hebrew words do not have vowels, so don't worry about the difference between the a in Tanakh and the o in Torah - those are for our benefit. The ending h helps denote the sound.
