<u>Prayer</u>: "Father, remind me of your goodness and your glory when I am facing difficult situations. Fill me with Your Spirit so that I may live as You desire and testify about You, making disciples of others as Jesus has commanded each of us to do."

**Weekly Nugget**: "Son of man" is a phrase used 93 times in Ezekiel. This phrase was a favorite of Jesus and He used it 80 times when referring to Himself (no one else called Jesus "son of man"). The usage of the phrase differs dramatically between Ezekiel and Jesus. For Ezekiel, the idea is to remind him of his human weakness as opposed to having the presence of a deity; however, for Jesus the idea was likely to note that He was indeed fully man, even as He was also fully God.
