Children’s Message

We’re Unfaithful Because We **Forget** (Ezekiel 16.62-63)

Prayer: “God, let me remember You daily. Remind me of Your faithfulness to me, that I may strive to be faithful to You in all that I do.”

Weekly Nugget: Ezekiel 16 is specifically addressed to Jerusalem (vv. 2-3). Jerusalem is being used as a representative term for Judah, which was the southern part of the kingdom after the split of Israel (immediately after Solomon’s death). The words to Jerusalem apply to all of Israel in one sense, but the northern kingdom (Israel, often called Samaria) had already been in exile for 125+ years, so this message, and all of Ezekiel, is truly meant for just the southern kingdom (represented by the tribes of Judah and Benjamin, but lumped together in name as Judah).
