<u>Prayer</u>: "Father, I want you to be my security – each and every day. Keep my eyes focused on You."

Weekly Nugget: Ezekiel is an interesting book because God had him record specific dates. For instance, Chapter 24 begins with the note that it is the ninth year, in the tenth month, on the tenth day of the month. The Bible uses multiple calendars throughout the time periods it records, but centered on the Julian calendar, the date means the prophecy was likely given in August. The exact time may not matter to us today, but the dates served as markers for the people then (just as they do for us today) and show us that God indeed works in history – or should I say His-story.
