**Weekly Nugget**: The Greek name of Jesus (Greek, Iesous, in English letters) comes from a similar spelling of the Hebrew. In the Hebrew language, the English equivalent would be HSY. In the Hebrew, the letters are backwards from the English, so HSY would be YSH in English. The Hebrew also does not include vowels, so the name Yeshua or Yoshua (English Joshua) are both possible pronunciations for the name we know as Jesus. Additionally, the "J" was not created as a letter for centuries afterward.
