Having announced our pending departure, I want to provide a bit of perspective. We have received a great deal of support, amidst the sadness, that comes with an announcement like the one we recently made. But Fairfax Baptist Church has been an important part of this community for 137.5 years, and she can continue to be for many years to come. In comparison, the Braams have only been a part of the community for 10.6 years (almost 11 by the time we leave) which is less than 8% of that time.

In other words, a great deal of ministry has happened before we came, and an opportunity for more ministry remains after we leave. Hopefully, we have done what God sent us to do for this church and for this community during our time here. Only time will tell.

But we all have a responsibility to continue the ministry that God has given each of us – as a part of Fairfax Baptist, yes, but as a part of building His Kingdom. As you may remember, we have recently changed the vision/mission statement of the church. Whether or not you retain the statement, the idea should be part of any Christian's mantra – *Building for Tomorrow by Sharing Christ Today*. Since the beginning of the pandemic, we have spent much time talking of love and hope, and along with faith, we have the great triad Paul mentioned in 1 Corinthians 13.13. Our world needs those three ideas as much as ever today.
